

The Ways We Serve Others Here and Abroad.

Here at St Paul, we are blessed with so many ways to offer help to others. Listed are some of the ways we serve:

Blood Drive: LifeServe's mobile blood drive is held at St. Paul the 4th Tuesday of every month.

Comforter's Quilters: This group meets at the church regularly on Wednesdays from 9 - 11 a.m.. The quilts are distributed to Lutheran World Relief, recent St Paul graduates, newborn babies and more.

Crop Walk: This is a community based walk and fundraising event held across the United States, to support the global mission of Church World Service. 25% of the funds raised is returned to the host community to support local hunger fighting efforts.

Furniture Ministry: St. Paul collects household goods, furnishings, and furniture to dontae to those in need.

Gods Work Our Hands: Once a year, about 50 members of St. Paul go out into the community, gathering at pre-selected homes where they clean up the yard, paint a bit, perhaps plant a few things, in general leaving the yard and home in better shape than when they arrived.

Matthew 25: Ministries: We collect clean used pill bottles with a plastic lid for international medical missions.

Pool of Siloam: This is a fund for those needing financial help for such things as gasoline, rent, utility payments, or emergencies.

Transportation Ministry: Members will provide transportation to those needing a ride to medical appointments in Winterset and the Des Moines metro.

At these family events, we always enjoy plenty of food to satiate the body and good conversation and laughter to satiate the soul.

Children and Youth: Young people of St. Paul are engaged throughout the school year in God Squad and Confirmation on Wednesday evenings. They start with a free meal, have class, and participate in activities to develop healthy relationships and deepen their understanding of God. Vacation Bible School is held every summer under the leadership of Lutheran Bible Camp counselors.
